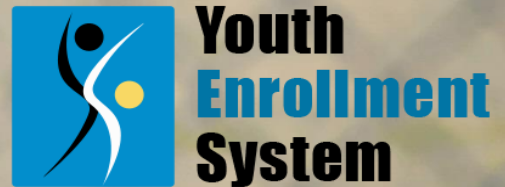

After unsuccessful experiences with other systems they set out to find a fast, reliable, and accurate solution. They found this possible by taking advantage of the Youth Enrollment System.

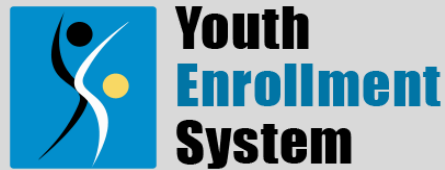

Challenge

Valuable staff time and energy was being ineffectively used to track, manage, and report tremendous amounts of data needed to request funding from grantors.

These methods were not effective or reliable and were extremely time consuming. A free member management system was available, but it just was not doing what they needed it to do.

Critical Factors



Annually, Waynesville R-VI deals with \$2-4 mil in grant reporting for the whole district.



More than 10,000 students rely on these programs every year.
